

Citing a Poem, a Chapter or a Large Section of a Book

Begin with the poem, chapter, or portion of the book that you read, and then add the book's citation information. (In the example below, the poem "Spanish Dancer" is cited.)

- Last name, first name of the author, followed by a period and a space.
- Name of chapter, poem, essay, etc. in "quotation marks" followed by a period.
- Title of book in *italics*, followed by a period and a space.
- City of publication, followed by a colon and a space.
- Name of publisher, followed by a comma and a space.
- Year of publication, followed by a period.
- Type the word Print followed by a period.

Example:

Rilke, Rainer Maria. "Spanish Dancer." *The Selected Poetry of Rainer Maria Rilke*. New York: Vintage International, 1982. Print.

Note: Please be sure to 'Reverse Indent' the second line of a citation.

To reverse indent, hold down the Control key and press the Tab key. Do you agree that this line is reversed indented?
